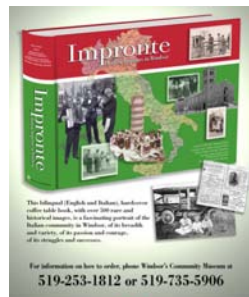

There will be a Limo Bus leaving the Caboto Club with a pick-up at Ciociaro Club to the Roma Club in Leamington.

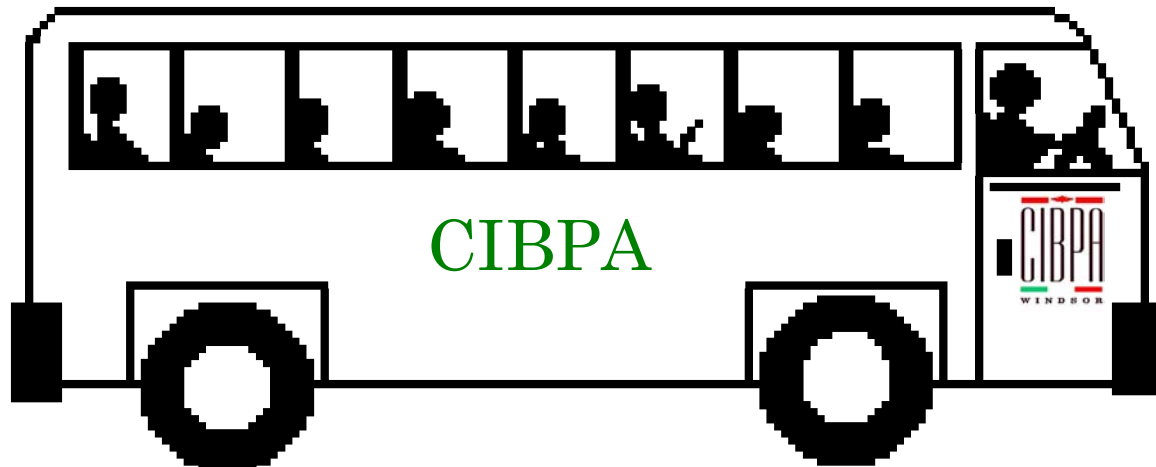
Cost is **\$15 / person**. There is only room for the first paid 20 persons (Minimum 18 persons) on a first come basis
