- 1) The <u>Civic Night</u> featuring Dr. Sergio Marchionne made it possible for CIBPA to take full credit for raising a total of \$220,000.00 for the University of Windsor Italian Studies Legacy Fund, and as well to establish two perpetual scholarship funds.

Plaque to mark family's gifts

Moceri name to grace diagnostic imaging unit

A philanthropic Windsor family was recognized Friday when In Honour of the Ones We Love made a \$30,000 donation in its name to aid in the treatment of cancer patients at Hotel-Dieu Grace Hospital.

The Moceri family, whose father Rocco died of cancer earlier this year, will have a plaque inscribed with Rocco and wife Antonia's name placed in the diagnostic imaging department at the hospital where the funds will be used for chemotherapy ports for people undergoing cancer treatments.

"It's a happy and emotional day for our family to be recognized in this way," said John

Moceri, Rocco's son and vicepresident of family-owned Windsor Disposal Services. "We've been fortunate to be able to raise funds through our annual golf tournament for In Honour of the Ones We Love because we know how many families, in addition to our own, have been touched by cancer in this area."

Moceri said that his mother

Antonia had a chemotherapy port installed just last week so "this really brings it all home to us and it's very gratifying to be recognized in this way."

Also on hand for the presentation were sons John and Vince as well as daughter Virginia Moceri. A chemotherapy port is a medical appliance installed beneath the skin to facilitate treatment. It reduces the pain during chemotherapy treatments and as a single site intravenous access point, it is easier to keep free of infection.

"The implant is a small reservoir placed beneath the skin which allows the medicine to trickle safely and slowly into the bloodstream," said Dr. Jack Spiers, an interventional radiologist at the hospital. Anita Imperioli, president of In Honour of the Ones We Love, said the organization chose to honour the Moceris because "they are truly an amazing family and they deserve to have this recognition for all they've done for our organization and cancer patients across the region."

Over the past five years, an annual WDS golf tournament has raised an average of \$28,000 for the organization.

Imperioli said that since being established 14 years ago, In Honour of the Ones We Love has raised more than \$4 million for area hospitals.




