I also want to remind all our members that 2011 is our 50th Anniversary year, so please support this great event and lets have another record breaking Golf Tournament.

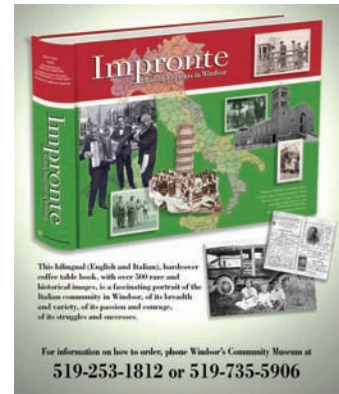

WIPBA's FIRST GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING

Dear Members, below are what I believe to be the minutes of the very first general membership meeting of the Windsor Italian Professional and Businessmen's Association (WIPBA) held on May 16, 1961. Take a minute to read them, and note the foresight that our founding fathers had. Fifty years later, our objectives are still pretty much the same. By the way, the annual dues of \$10.00 (#3) did not include the monthly dinners, which at that time were paid by the members. We also did away with #8 quite a few years ago, otherwise today our membership would have been capped at 61+50=111.

MINUTES OF MEETING

A meeting was held by the members of the Windsor Italian Professional and Businessmen's Association on May 16th at 6:30 p.m. 1961 at Mario's Tavern, Windsor.

Mr Roland J. Baldassi acted as Interim Chairman of the Club and was in the chair.

There was a discussion as to the object clause of the organization;



1. MOVED By Gus Morianti and seconded by Nello Dario, that the objects would be cultural, educational and charitable; The vote was unanimous;
2. MOVED by Frank Tintinelli and seconded by John Cazzola that the general meeting of the club should be on the third Tuesday of each and every month, which would be a dinner meeting with the exception that there would be no meetings during the months of July and August; The vote in favour was unanimous;
3. MOVED by Tony Soda and seconded by Elio Danilon that the initiation fee of the organization would be \$25.00 and yearly dues \$10.00; The vote was unanimous;
4. MOVED by Frank Bernachi and seconded by Gus Morianti that the general meetings of the organization be held at Mario's Tavern at 755 Ouellette Avenue, Windsor; Adopted;
5. MOVED by John Cazzola and seconded by Tony Soda that the qualifications for membership would be that the applicant must be of Italian descent or birth and be of Canadian citizenship; Adopted;
6. MOVED by John Cazzola and seconded by Nello Dario that applicants for membership would have to be of professional standing, in that they must have, e.g.
  - (a) University degree, and/or
  - (b) Self-employed business man, and/or
  - (c) Director or Officer of a limited corporation, or an executive of a corporation or business, and/or
  - (d) Clergyman;
 The motion was unanimously adopted;
7. MOVED by Tony Valente and seconded by Frank Tintinelli that an applicant for membership must be of the full age of 21 years; Adopted;
8. MOVED by Tony Soda and carried unanimously that the club is to have 61 members and on each yearly anniversary of the founding of the club, one additional member would be admitted;

There was a general discussion that the name of the organization should be the Windsor Italian Professional and Businessmen's Association or Windsor Italian Service Club.


Mr Frank Bernachi discussed generally, the outline for a project involving deaf and dumb children.

It was announced that the next dinner meeting would be Tuesday, June 20th 1961 at the same place, and that the executive meeting would be held Monday, June 5th at 8 p.m.

9. MOVED by Frank Bernachi and seconded by Aldo Schincariol that the meeting be adjourned. Carried.
