Our Guest Speaker this month is **Dr. John A. Strasser**, President St. Clair College. Dr. John A. Strasser was born and raised in Sydney, Nova Scotia. His received an Engineering diploma from St. Francis Xavier University, an Associate Degree in Business Management from LaSalle University, Master of Science degree from Pennsylvania State University and a Doctorate degree in Metallurgical Engineering from the Technical University of Nova Scotia.

He was appointed as President of



St. Clair College on August 1, 2000. St. Clair College has three campuses in our area. The main campus is located in South Windsor, a downtown Windsor Campus and a Chatham Campus.

During his first decade of service as President of St. Clair College he has resulted in an enrolment increase of more than fifty (50) percent.

Since 2000, St. Clair College has completed the construction of the Ford Centre for Excellence in Manufacturing, a new addition to the Student Centre, a Centre for Construction, Innovation and Production, a MediaPlex in the downtown Windsor core and has established the St. Clair College Centre for the Arts on Riverside Drive. In addition, this September, the College opened a Trades and Technology Centre and a student HealthPlex in Chatham. In Windsor, the Truck and Coach Repair Centre in Windsor and the Applied Health Sciences Centre in Windsor.

Under his leadership, the College has the first student residences in both Windsor and in Chatham.

Dr. Strasser and his wife Gayle, an elementary school teacher at Southwood School in Windsor, have two sons Andrew and Kirby, a daughter-in-law Amy (Burkholder) and three granddaughters Leah, Andrea and Addison.
