 - 5.1.2. An official transcript of grades;



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- 5.1.3. A plan of study;
- 5.1.4. A statement describing the applicant's community involvement;
- 5.1.5. Information confirming the applicant's financial need should the applicant wish this criterion to be considered; and,
- 5.1.6. Any information which the applicant may wish the scholarship committee to consider or which the scholarship committee may require.

The CIBPA Scholarship Committee has the right to ask for verification of any information submitted and to interview candidates and their references whenever it is deemed necessary by the Committee.
